

# THE HARDING MILLER EDUCATION FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS

## INTRODUCTION

This document outlines the Terms and Conditions for scholarships administered by the Harding Miller Education Foundation ('Harding Miller').

You must read these Terms and Conditions in full. **In accepting a scholarship from Harding Miller, it is understood that you have read and agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.**

Please note, since you are under 18 years of age, your parent or guardian must read and consent to these Terms and Conditions on your behalf.

## ACCEPTING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP

Successful scholarship applicants will receive an email notification. If you do not wish to accept the scholarship you are offered, you should advise us immediately in writing, either by letter or email. Your scholarship details may be passed on to your school, your parent or carer, donors, suppliers or partner organisations.

## UPDATING HARDING MILLER

Each academic year for the duration of your scholarship, you will be asked to complete an online check-in survey which will include uploading your most recent academic results. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide this report to Harding Miller by the specified time. Failure to complete the annual survey by the specified time may result in cancellation of the scholarship.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All scholarships are awarded on the basis that you will maintain an enrolled status at a public school in Australia. Your scholarship will be terminated if your enrolment status changes, for example if you discontinue your school studies, transfer to a non-government school or move overseas.

To retain your scholarship, you must also:

- adhere to the academic and administrative policies of the school and/or education institution at which you are enrolled;
  - meet any additional criteria outlined in your email notification;
  - provide confirmation of your circumstances during the term of the scholarship if requested by Harding Miller;
  - actively participate in the program and make use of the tools and resources provided; and
  - Adhere to guidelines when meeting with your coach.

## SCHOLARSHIP TERMINATION

Harding Miller may terminate your scholarship if you have:

- discontinued from your government school or approved course of study or have inactive enrolment;
- failed to meet the eligibility requirements of your scholarship;
- failed to meet the scholarship's Terms and Conditions;
- failed to maintain satisfactory academic progress;
- failed to maintain satisfactory school attendance;
- been suspended or excluded from school or your course of study;
- been made an incorrect scholarship offer as determined by Harding Miller at its sole discretion; and/or
- have provided incorrect, false or misleading information or withheld relevant information on your scholarship application or after receiving a scholarship offer.

If your scholarship is terminated prior to you completing year 12, you will be required to return your laptop and you will not receive any further broadband, helpdesk support or tutoring and your pre-paid card will be cancelled.

## TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

As part of your scholarship, you will be provided with a high-quality laptop and a protective, padded cover case and you are required to take all reasonable care of your laptop. Harding Miller does not offer any warranty period and accepts no liability for any loss or damage of the equipment. You may be required to cover the cost of repairs or replacement of equipment where repairs are deemed not to have occurred through reasonable/normal use.

## PUBLICITY & PROMOTION

If you are offered a scholarship, your details including name, school, photograph, video and scholarship awarded may be passed on to media and used by Harding Miller and organisations that we work with for promotional purposes, including but not limited to Harding Miller's website, social media channels, print / electronic media and reports. If you do not wish for your details to be passed on to media or used for promotional purposes, you must notify Harding Miller in writing.

If you attend events held by Harding Miller or organisations that we work with, photos and videos of you at the event (along with your first name, school and scholarship details), may be used for promotional purposes by Harding Miller and organisations that we work with, including but not limited to Harding Miller's website, social media channels, print / electronic media and reports

Scholarship recipients waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product, the promotional copy or other matter that may be used in connection therewith or the use to which it may be applied. If you do not wish photographs and videos of you to be used in this way, you must notify Harding Miller in writing.

## LIABILITY WAIVER

In accepting a scholarship from Harding Miller, you agree to WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE Harding Miller, its officers, associates and partner organisations from any and all liability, including but not limited to, any liability arising from the negligence or fault of the entities or persons released, for death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, or actions of any kind which may occur to you during or after the scholarship period, including during or after any travel undertaken as part of the scholarship.

## KEEPING YOUR CONTACT DETAILS UP TO DATE

All correspondence during the application process will be sent to the applicant's personal email address submitted in the scholarship application form. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to inform Harding Miller of any changes to their email, contact phone number(s), postal or residential address. Your Principal will also be notified of the outcome of your application. It is also the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to inform Harding Miller if they change their place of schooling, or any personal contact details, during the course of their scholarship.

Please note, since you are under 18 years of age, it is understood that your parent or guardian has read and agreed to the scholarship Terms and Conditions on your behalf. Harding Miller reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions for commencing and continuing scholarship holders.
